7 p.m. Spirited Leadership: A Conversation with Ellen Castro

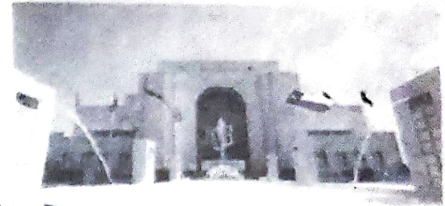
